Muriel's grandmother (Zenna Rintoull) was the first teacher for Morwell (she had 12 children). The Morwell Historical Society recently did an article on Zenna.

I'm looking forward to our reunion in March 2005 and Muriel hopes to attend. Also expecting to come is Pam Wilson who now lives in Albury. Pam is daughter of Henry Wilson, the Yallourn Butcher.
